

# *NLWL White Oak Savanna Jewelry*

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Q. Where does your jewelry come from?**

A: Our jewelry is made exclusively for us by Wild Bryde Jewelry, El Sobrante, California ([www.wildbryde.com](http://www.wildbryde.com)). Mike Warner, the owner of Wild Bryde, is a graduate of the California College of Arts and Crafts in Oakland. He has been making jewelry for over 25 years. We have worked closely with Mike to design a line of jewelry fashioned after a photo of a White Oak tree from the West Linn White Oak Savanna. All of the jewelry is made entirely in the USA.

### **Q: How is the jewelry made?**

A: Each piece is hammered by hand with a special planishing tool. This strengthens the jewelry and gives it subtle and attractive light-reflecting facets.

### **Q: What is the jewelry made of?**

A: The base metal is re-cycled brass. This is then plated in either 14k gold or rhodium (a non-tarnishing silver alloy). The earwires on the earrings are 14k gold-fill and sterling silver, respectively. Clip-ons are also available.

### **Q: How big are the pieces?**

A: In order from smallest to largest (diameter):

Men's lapel pin	0.75 inches
Necklace	0.75 inches
Earrings w/ acrylic back and bead	0.75 inches
Earrings	1 inch
Women's pin	2 inches

All values are approximate.

### **Q: How quickly will I get my jewelry after I place an order?**

A: We will do all we can to ship your order within 2-3 weeks of receipt. However, during especially busy times delivery may take longer. Please contact us at [info@nlwl.org](mailto:info@nlwl.org) if you have any questions about your order.

### **Q: How do I clean my jewelry?**

A: We recommend using diluted Windex or hot water and soap. Dry with a clean, soft, non-abrasive cloth. The rhodium (silver alloy) finish earrings will not tarnish.

### **Q: Is the jewelry heavy?**

A: Everybody who buys our jewelry comments that they love wearing it because it is so light.
